Do I need a permit to remove my tree(s)?

A person shall not allow the removal of any tree without first obtaining a permit from the Town. Please contact the Landscaping Division at 954-797-1072 for additional information.

What about trimming?

You are permitted to prune your trees in Davie without a permit, but it is recommended that you us a licensed arborist to do so.
