### **Do I need a permit to remove my tree(s)?**

Yes. You are not allow to remove, relocate or destroy any tree in Prembroke Pines Florida without first obtaining a permit from the city.

The city will require a reason for removal such as the tree is in poor condition, dead or hazardous.

### **When can I remove my tree(s) without a permit?**

It is not possible to remove a tree in prembroke pines without a first obtaining a permit.
