# TREE REMOVAL PERMIT PLANTATION FL



### Do I need a permit to remove my tree(s)?

The city of plantation does require a permit before any tree removal or pruning work is carried out.

Even once approval is obtained you may not prune or trim any more than 25% of the canopy of a tree or palms.

Had racking or topping trees is strictly prohibited.

## What about palm trees?

You may remove dead frons, but you are not able to remove frons above the horizon line.
